

Sonar and Ideal 18 Runaground Policy Updated Apr 1, 2025

Definitions:

Runaground- running aground on any shoreline or islands. Skipper- Person at the helm of the boat at the time of the runaground. Responsible party- The person with the appropriate ratings to sign the boat out.

Policy:

If a Sonar or Ideal 18 is runaground, they will be brought back to the mooring where they will derig and be returned to the dock. If the runaground occurs within the channel markers, they will be allowed to continue sailing.

Procedure:

Ratings for the current flag color will be revoked according to the following: Skipper is responsible party- rating is revoked. Responsible party is onboard but not skippering- Responsible party's rating is revoked. Multiple appropriately rated parties are onboard: Whichever person was the skipper loses their rating.

Re-testing: 1st incident of the season- Standard on the water retest

2nd incident and beyond- Written test with program director and on the water retest.

The hull will be marked out of service and will not return to service until the Fleet Maintenance team is able to hoist and inspect the hull for new damage.
